2010 Summer Institute in Foreign Languages & Linguistics

- **Institute Check-in:** Mondays, 9:00a-9:30a
Living/Learning Center (LLC), Great Hall, Room 205

There will be light food and coffee available during check-in.
Come early and get comfortable in your target language!

If you're taking just the afternoon class, check in at 12:40p at the beginning of the target language lunch, also in the Great Hall, LLC 205.

Any participant with an Institute balance may pay by check during check-in. You must pay academic credit fees with a separate check to Student Accounts.

- **Institute Class: in Living Learning Center (LLC)**

The Living/Learning Center (LLC) is located opposite the new sports complex off Bodenheimer Drive; it's directly behind the Institute dorm (Winkler Hall) and near the parking for the Institute (Stadium Parking Lot).

The LLC has a "U" shape, with stairs running up in the middle of the "U".
For purposes of orientation, if you are walking UP the stairs into the "U"
the Great Hall will be on your LEFT.

- **Parking**

Parking passes will be mailed to you prior July 12. Please do not forget your permit(s) as a new one is \$10 per week.

Park in the **Stadium Parking Lot**-- large parking lot located beside the football stadium & Winkler Hall. The cross streets are Rivers Street and Stadium Drive.

- **Other helpful details**

- Classes start at 9:40a. Morning classes are 9:40a-12:40p, and the afternoon class is 1:40p-4:40p. We'll have regular breaks, and one hour for target language lunches in French, German, and Spanish.
- Please bring your own notebooks, pens, etc. A good target language dictionary would also be excellent. We'll provide printing cards so you can print a set number of pages in the library. If you need more pages, you can reload your card.
- We'll expect participants to speak the target language during social time, at target-language lunches, and in the university's housing facilities, and we'll ask you to sign a language pledge at check-in.
- Bring a laptop if you have one. There is access to computers and printers in Belk Library and Information Commons. There is wireless internet in the LLC. Bring an Ethernet cable for Winkler Hall.

➤ **For those w/ CAMPUS LODGING:**

- 1) Lodging starts SUNDAY NIGHT to accommodate early check-in at the Institute on Monday morning.

If you haven't reserved a room for the entire weekend, you will check-out of your dorm during the day each Friday.

Dorm where you'll be staying: Winkler Hall **Check in time:** Between 5p-7p, Sundays.

Location of Check-in to your dorm: On Sunday, July 11th from 5-7pm: Winkler Hall Lobby

If you need to check in after 7pm, or if you are checking in on Sunday, July 18th or 25th: Coltrane Hall 24hr summer desk (on the left, as you come up Stadium drive, behind Garner Hall)

This is where you'll pick up linens and keys. Also where you will drop off linens & keys at check-out.

Both dorms are accessible from the Stadium Drive. Campus map: <http://maps.appstate.edu/>

- 2) **Evening meals** (M-Th) are included in lodging package (all you can eat) in Rivers Street Café in the new Central Dining Hall. This will be the side of the cafeteria that is closest to Rivers Street with cafeteria style dining, not Sanford Commons, the side closest to Sanford mall. The Central Dining Facility is open till 7 p.m.
- 3) **Breakfast is not included** in your lodging/dinner package (but you will have a fridge, stove, & microwave in your suite, read below for what else to bring).

Dorm details/What to bring:

Winkler Hall has single rooms, with four singles to a suite. You will be grouped by gender and by language. Participants commit to speaking the target language in your dorms 24/7. You will share a bathroom with 1 other person

Dorm space is NOT air-conditioned-- bring a fan if you want one.

Each suite has a stove, fridge, & microwave, but no cooking utensils, so bring dishes/paper plates, a coffeepot, tea kettle, cups, pans, toaster, etc. as you wish.

Linens (towels & sheets) are provided each week when you check in to your dorm.

If you're bringing a laptop, bring an Ethernet cable for Internet access in Winkler Hall. Wireless is available most other places on campus.
